## **ROLL CALL**

The Council Members that had not been sworn in, were sworn in by Mr. Burson.

## **NEW BUSINESS**

Position five (5) on the Council is still vacant. Mr. Manning declined the position. The talks were tabled until the next meeting.

The Arkansas Environmental Training Academy, a division of SAU Tech, has partnered with the Arkansas Department of Agriculture's Natural Resources Division to provide the water board training for Act 605 of 2021. Act 605 of 2021 tasked retail water providers with additional responsibilities in managing and operating their water systems. Three Council Members will be required to take an eight (8) hour class on the computer. If a Council Member has been on the Council for ten (10) years they would be exempt from the training.
